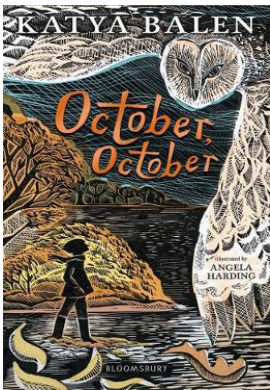

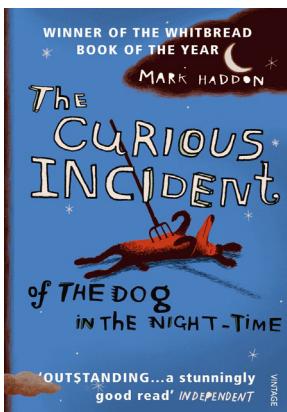
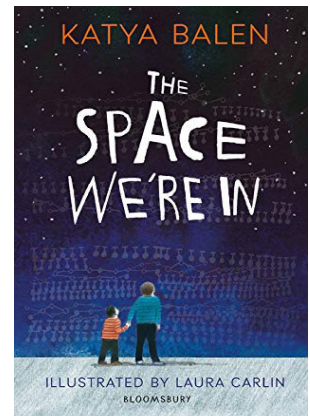


Year 7: 'October, October' by Katya Balen

A timeless tale of wild nature and family secrets boasting a cast of unforgettable characters. This book is a feast for the senses, filled with the woodsmoke smell of crisp autumn mornings and the sound of wellies squelching in river mud. And, as October fights to find the space to be wild in the whirling chaos of the world beyond the woods, it is also a feast for the soul.

Year 8: 'The Space We're In' by Katya Balen

We are her world and her universe and her space and stars and skys, galaxy and cosmos too. When tragedy hits Frank and Max's lives like a comet, can they piece together a universe in which they aren't lightyears apart? This heartbreaking but hopeful novel will remind you we are all made of stardust.

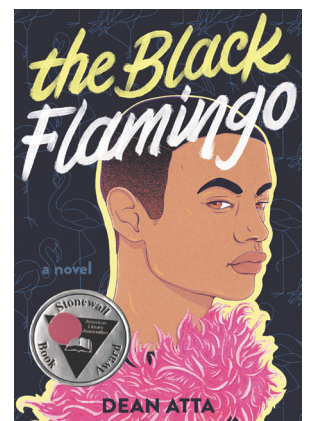


Year 9: 'The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time' by Mark Haddon

A follow-along adventure in the life of fifteen-year-old Christopher who has Asperger's syndrome. Christopher has never gone further than the end of the road on his own, but when he finds a neighbour's dog murdered he sets out on a terrifying journey which will turn his whole world upside down.

Year 10: 'The Black Flamingo' by Dean Atta

An exploration of a mixed-race LGBTQ+ experience in Britain, The Black Flamingo is a bold story about the power of embracing your uniqueness and finding your inner strength. Sometimes, we need to take charge, to stand up wearing pink feathers - to show ourselves to the world in bold colour.
