There will be signposting in place to direct students and families through one of our pedestrian gates and the route to follow towards the canteen. Please take time to read this as it contains important information related to the collection of and interpretation of GCSE marks and results.

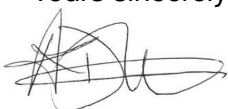
